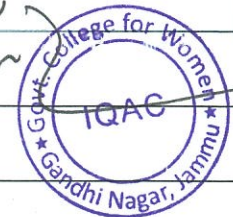



**“RULES & REGULATIONS OF THE SOCIETY”**

**1. NAME OF THE SOCIETY**

The name of the Society shall be **“ALUMNI ASSOCIATION OF PADMA SHRI PADMA SACHDEV GOVERNMENT COLLEGE FOR WOMEN GANDHI NAGAR JAMMU”**.

**AREA OF OPERTION : JAMMU AND KASHMIR**

DEFINITIONS: – In these Rules & Regulations’ unless there is anything repugnant in the subject or context.

- a. The society means “The Society registered under Societies Registration Act, 1860”.
- b. The governing body means the Governing body/ executive committee or the managing committee of the society
- c. The General body means: – the general body of the society
- d. The executive member means: – the member of the society
- e. The member means: – the member of the society.
- f. The patron means:- The Patron of the society

**2. MEMBERSHIP**

The membership of the Society is open to any person who has attained the age of maturity and fulfills the terms and conditions of the Society but subject to approval of the Governing Body of the Society.

There shall be three types of membership as mentioned hereunder:

- (i) **Founder Life Members** : The signatories to the Memorandum of Association as desirous persons and who are also the members of first Governing Body shall be called Founder Life Members of the Society and jointly they will be called Board of Founder Life Members.
- (ii) **Life Members** : All major individuals who have attained the age of maturity and who fulfills the terms and conditions of the Society may apply to the secretary on prescribed form to become a member of the Society and the Society may enroll such a person on payment of admission fee, as member of the Society. The request so received shall be placed by the Secretary in consultation with the President before the Governing Body and the Governing Body may approve or disapprove the name,

- (iii) **Honorary members** : Honorary members be extended in case of a specific person as deemed fit by the Governing Body

**Note:** If the membership is not approved by the Governing Body, the reason for refusal shall be communicated to the concerned person/ applicant.

### 3. ADMISSION FEE & SUBSCRIPTION

The admission fee and the subscription shall be as under;

- a) Admission Fee (at the time of admission): Rs. 1000.
- b) Annual Subscription monthly Rs. Nil

The membership fee/ annual subscription fee can be changed by the Governing Body of the Society as and when required.

### 4. REFUSAL FOR MEMBERSHIP

The Governing Body may refuse any person for membership provided the reasons for refusal are communicated to the concerned person/ applicant.

### 5. WITHDRAWAL OF MEMBERSHIP

Any member may withdraw from the membership an express desire to do so through a letter addressed to the General Secretary/Secretary.

### 6. TERMINATION/ CESSATION OF MEMBERSHIP

The Governing Body of the Society shall have the powers to terminate a member(s) from the membership of the above Society on the following grounds:

- a) On her involving in anti national activity
- b) On her becoming insolvent
- c) If the member fails to pay the subscription timely and continuously for 3 (three) months from the due date of paying the fee However, a reminder notice (oral/ written) shall be first given by the Governing Body / any authorized person for the payment of subscription fee before termination of his membership on this ground
- d) If the member works against the aims of the Society or disregards the Rules & Regulations or the decisions of the Governing Body
- e) If the member tenders her unnecessary resentment in the decisions of the society

- f) If she is found to be involved in any anti-social activity
- g) If she is adjudged by any court of law to be a criminal offender or of unsound mind
- h) If she is found guilty by the Governing Body by means of anti social propaganda of the aims and objectives of the society
- i) If the member fails to attend three consecutive meetings without proper intimation to the Society.

**NOTE:-**

(i) The reason of termination from the membership of the Society shall be communicated to the concerned member in writing through any delay

(ii) A member expelled from the membership of the Society shall have no right to enjoy the 'Rights & Privileges' mentioned in clause 8 of these Rules & regulations of the society

**7. APPEAL AND RE-ADMISSION**

Every terminated member shall have a right to appeal before the Governing Body for re- admission and the decision of the Governing Body shall be final.

**8. RIGHTS AND PRIVILEGES OF MEMBERS**

Every Member shall have the following rights and privileges in the SOCIETY;

- a. Have one vote at every meeting
- b. To vote in the election of the Governing Body and to hold office in the Governing Body if elected for any position
- c. Every member, their spouse, their dependent children, their parents and guest may use the facilities provided by the SOCIETY on payment of fee/charges as fixed by the Governing Body time to time
- d. To take part in seminars, meetings, lectures, discussion, conferences, cultural and/ or religious functions, tours and other lawful gatherings of the SOCIETY if desired as such by the Governing body
- e. Have right to collect the Identity Card after depositing the required prescribed fee (fixed by the Governing Body).

**9. DUTIES OF MEMBERS All and every member of the Society shall:-**

- a. Administer the oath of office and loyalties to the Society and/ or its
- b. Elect the Governing Body of the

- c. Attend the General Body meetings regularly.
- d. Give necessary information to the Society pertaining to any matter which is necessary to be known by the Society.
- e. Not Indulge in activities which are prejudicial to the Aims and Objectives and / or the Rules and Regulations of the Society.

10. **GENERAL BODY**

- a) **Constitution of General Body** All the members of the Society shall constitute the 'GENERAL BODY' of the Society.
- b) **Meetings**
  - (i) The meetings of the General Body shall be held at least once in a month in the office of the society
  - (ii) The emergency meeting of the General Body may be held at any time as desired by the Governing body.
- c) **Venue of Meetings** The time, date and place of meeting shall be decided by the Governing Body and shall be notified to all members on roll of the Society with not less than 15 days clear notice and emergency meeting may be summoned within 3 days notice.
- d) **Quorum** The quorum of the General Body meetings shall be 2/3rd of the members on roll of the Society. In the absence of the requisite quorum in any meeting, the meeting shall be adjourned for number of days as decided by the present members in the meeting and no quorum shall be required in the meeting reconvened after adjournment. However the meeting cannot be adjourned beyond 7 days.
- e) **Works to be transacted:** The following work may be transacted in the General Body meetings as put forth by the Governing Body.

To elect President, Secretary, Treasurer and executive members of the Governing Body.

To approve annual programmes and policies of the society

To pass annual budget of the SOCIETY.

To discuss and decide all other matters, things and issues which are directly and/or indirectly relates to the affairs of the society

11. **GOVERNING BODY** The management and administration of the affairs of the Society or control and supervision of the activities taken by the Society together with all its property of any nature or sort shall rest in the hands of the Governing Body.

a) **Strength** The strength of the Governing Body (including office bearers and executive members) shall not be less than 7 (seven) and not more than 21 (twenty one).









b) **Composition** The composition of the Governing body shall be as under:-

- c) **TERM** : the term of every Governing Body shall be of Three Years.
- d) **NOTICE** : Minimum 15 days clear notice shall be required for the Governing Body meeting enclosing the agenda specifying date, time, place and the general nature of business to be discussed at such Governing Body meeting.
- e) **QUORUM** : Quorum of every Governing Body meeting shall be 2/3rd of the total strength of the Governing Body (including Office bearers and executive members) In the absence of the requisite quorum in any meeting, the meeting shall be adjourned for number of days as decided by the present members in the meeting and no quorum shall be required in the meeting reconvened after adjournment. However, the meeting cannot be adjourned beyond 7 days.
- f) **MEETINGS** : Governing Body meeting shall be held once in 3 months (or as and when the Governing Body of the Society may decide from time to time).
- g) **EMERGENCY MEETINGS**: The emergency meeting of the Governing Body may be called by 24 hour notice but quorum for the same shall be 2/3rd of the total strength of the Governing Body of the Society.
- h) **VENUE OF MEETINGS** : The time, date and place of the meeting shall be decided by the General Secretary/Secretary in consultation with the President and Chairperson shall be notified to all members of the Governing Body with a clear notice of seven days.
- i) **FILLING UP OF VACANCIES** : In case of any vacancy the president in consultation with chairperson the General Secretary/Secretary may fill-up the vacancy(s) by nomination out of the members of the Society for the remaining period of the term of the Governing Body.
- j) Functions & Powers of Governing Body

- (i) The Governing Body shall be responsible for the management for the management and administration of the affairs of the society. The Governing Body is authorized to appoint any member to look after any particular matter / function / institute or the property of the society.

  - a. To prepare plans and programmes for the upliftment of the Aims and Objectives of the society.
  - b. To receive and to keep in custody of and to expend the funds / moveable or immoveable properties and to manage the same
  - c. To appoint, control & terminate such staff as may be required for effective & efficient management of the affairs of the society. Governing Body shall appoint Election- Officer to complete the election process.
  - d. To arrange finance, if required from Bank(s), Institutions (or / and) Individual on reasonable terms & conditions and the Governing Body as a whole is liable for its return.
  - e. To publish literature & to propagate the system to approach the public, pertaining to upliftment/attainment of the Aims & Objectives of the society
  - f. To accept donations, charities, loans, grants, properties etc. from the members, public, other Associations, Agencies and from Govt. or / and Semi Govt. Departments. To nominate the managing committee of any schools of the society or to nominate any committee or sub-committee of any one or more members of the society in the interest of obtaining the aims and objectives of the society

## **12. POWERS & DUTIES OF OFFICE BEARERS**

### **a) Powers of a chairperson/president in the society**

- i) The Chairperson has the power of overall superintendence and control in respect of the management of the affairs of the Society and to conduct the Elections.

### President

- (i) Every meeting of the Society, Governing Body, General Body shall be headed by the President or any person authorized by the President from time to time
- (ii) In case of equality of votes in any meeting, the President has the power to cast an extra vote to decide the
- (iii) In case of any matters requiring an urgent decision and sufficient time is not available to call for a Governing Body meeting, the President shall have the powers to decide the issue/ matter. However the President shall bring the matter to the notice of Governing Body at the earliest
- (iv) All the documents on behalf of the Society shall be signed by at least two members of the Governing Body including President except the documents specifically mentioned in the Memorandum of the association

### **b) Vice President**

- i) In the absence of President, the Vice President shall exercise all the powers and functions of the President.
- ii) He/she shall perform such other duties and functions as may be entrusted to him by the Governing body

### **c) Secretary**

- i) shall be responsible for the overall functioning of the Society as per procedure and norms laid down in the Memorandum of Association as well as in the Rules and Regulations of the Society.
- ii) Shall maintain all records of the Society and also supervise the accounts maintained by the Treasurer.
- iii) Shall submit annual report on audit of accounts of the Society in the General Body meeting of the Society.

**d) General Secretary**

iii) He/she shall maintain the Register of names, addresses and occupations of the members of the Association.

iv) The General Secretary shall make all correspondences, and coordinate the preparation and distribution of publications of The Association.

v) He/she shall prepare Annual Report of the Association, every year, for presenting in the meeting of Governing Body.

vi) He/she shall maintain all the records, documents minutes of the meetings of the Governing Body and Annual Reports etc.

**e) Joint Secretary**

i) The Joint Secretary shall work with the General Secretary in the management of the Association.

**13. SOURCE OF INCOME**

(iii) Fund collected by the society through any cultural programme, exhibitions or any function organized by the society. The funds of the Society shall be utilized only for the attainment of the aims and objectives of the Society.

(iv) Funding from the MNCs, Cooperative Societies, Trust, Central Govt., State Govt. and other Govt., another NGOs

**14. OPERATION OF BANK ACCOUNTS**

The Bank accounts of the Society shall be operated in any scheduled bank by the Chairperson and President of the Society under the joint signatures.

**15. FINANCIAL YEAR**

The financial year of the Society shall start from 1st Day of April to 31st Day of March next year.

Once in a year a list of office bearers and Executive members of the Governing Body of SOCIETY shall be filed with the office of the Registrar of Societies, as is required under section 4 of the Societies Registration Act, 1860.

20. **LEGAL PROCEEDINGS (SECTION 6)**

The SOCIETY may sue or be sued in the name of the President or Secretary as per provisions laid down under Section 6 of the Societies Registration Act, 1860, as applicable to Name of the State.

21. **AMENDMENTS (SECTION 12 & 12 A)**

Any amendment in the Memorandum of Association and Rules & Regulations shall be carried out as per provisions and procedures laid down under section 12 and 12 A of the Societies Registration Act 1860 , as applicable to Name of the State

22. **DISSOLUTION AND ADJUSTMENT OF AFFAIRS (SECTION 13 & 14)**

If the SOCIETY needs to be dissolved it shall be dissolved as per provisions laid down under section 13 & 14 of the societies Registration Act, 1860 as applicable to Name of the State.

23. **APPLICATION OF THE ACT**
