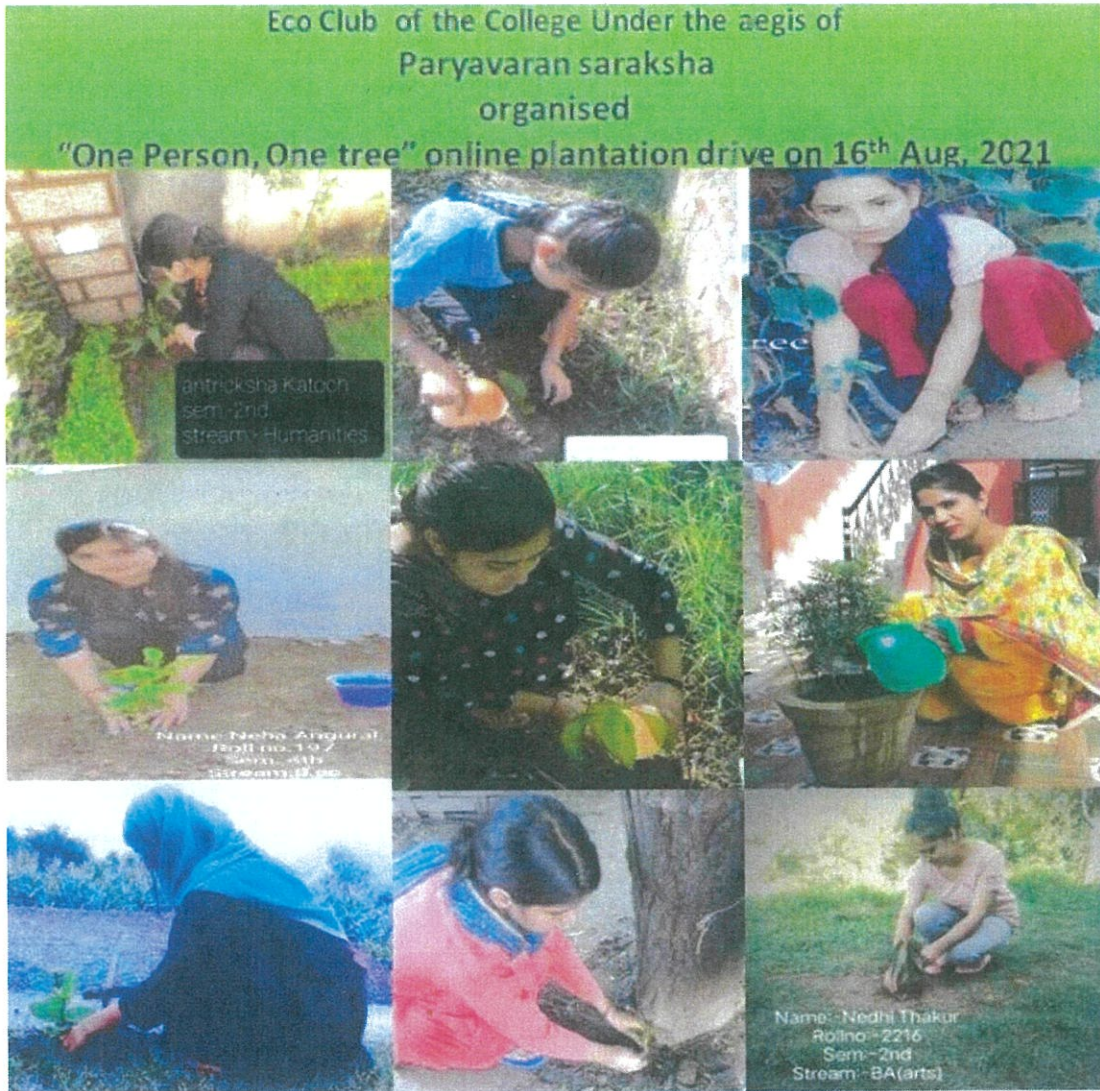

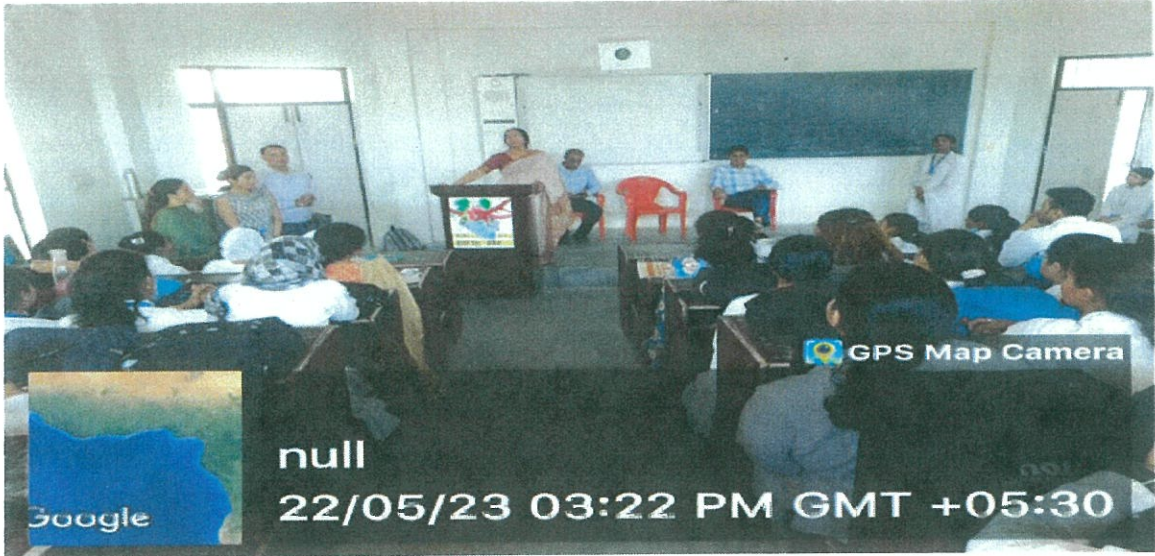


Activity Report

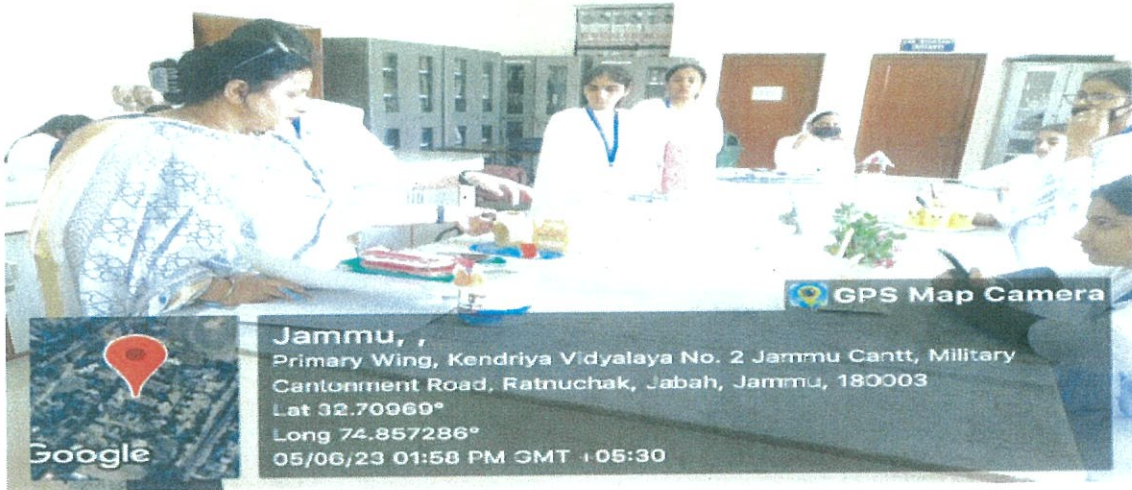
